



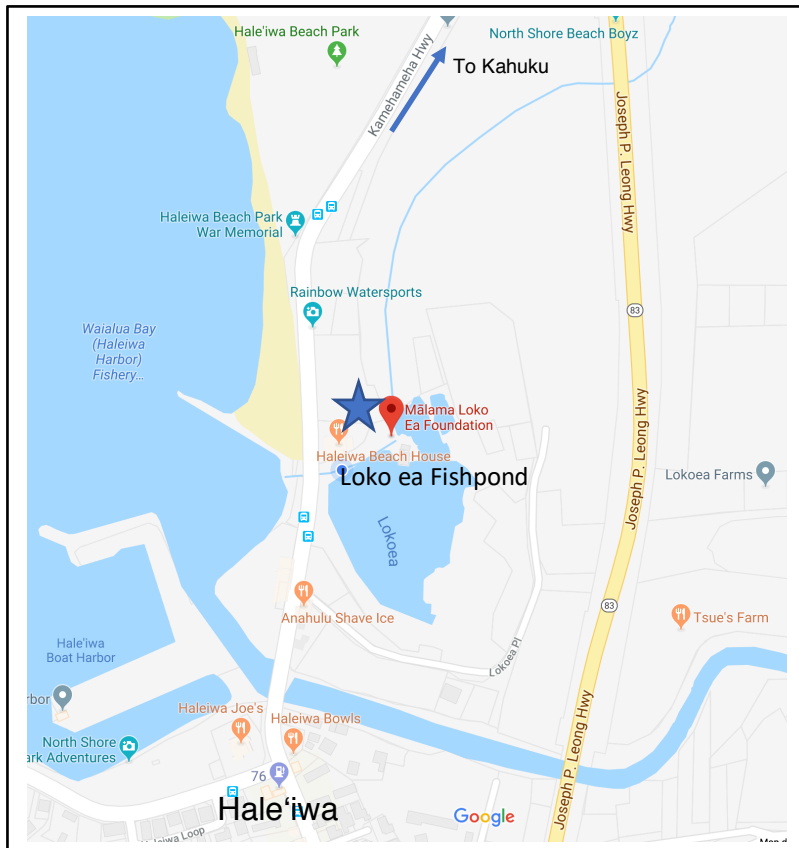

DIRECTIONS TO LOKO EA FISHPOND

Directions:

Loko ea is located just outside the heart of Haleʻiwa Town on the North Shore of Oʻahu.

From Honolulu take the Interstate H-1 W to Interstate H-2 N. Take exit 8 toward Wahiawa and continue on HI-99 N- Kamehameha Hwy to Haleiwa. GPS 21.596028, -158.102138



From Haleʻiwa Town:

- Coming through Haleʻiwa town, cross over Anahulu bridge (aka Rainbow Bridge). You will pass Surf and Sea Shop to the left and continue a short way until you see Haleiwa Beach House Restaurant on your right.
- Turn right into the dirt lot just past the Restaurant. If you reach Haleiwa Beach Park War Memorial, you've gone too far.

From Kahuku, Kamehameha hwy (83) north, or the Bypass road:

- Drive about ½ mile, passing Haleʻiwa Beach Park and the Haleiwa Beach Park War Memorial on your right.
- Turn left into the dirt parking lot just before Haleiwa Beach House Restaurant. If you reach Anahulu Bridge, you've gone too far.

★ **Parking:** Visitors to Loko ea can park anywhere in the dirt parking lot. The entrance to Loko ea is located in the back of the parking area through the green gate. Please do not park in the paved area for the restaurant visitors.

Bus Info for Fieldtrips and other groups: Buses may unload students and visitors in the back of the dirt parking lot, under the large Monkeypod tree, however buses can not park here. Once students have unloaded, please move the bus and park on the far side of the dirt parking lot near the road during the fieldtrip.

NOTE: Please do not block access to the back gate. This is our emergency vehicle access road.
